## Improvement

- Improved: A wireless vulnerability, known as 'KRACK' was discovered in October 2017. This affected wireless clients, including phones, tablets, laptops and also any wireless base acting as a client.

The recommended action in all cases is to upgrade your client devices as that is where the vulnerability lies however if that is impossible because the product is too old or the vendor does not provide updates, it is possible to mitigate KRACK exploitation by disabling EAPOL-Key retries on the base station and reduce the possibility of KRACK being used. Upgrading your client is still the preferable solution.
